- impartial feedback and assessment by experienced adjudicators

## Who can take part?

The competition is open to teams of three who must be aged between 7 and 10 on the qualifying date, which is 31<sup>st</sup> August 2023.

Each team is composed of a chairperson, speaker and proposer of a vote of thanks.
